2 and if not, then the group sponsoring the initiative would
3 be able to withdraw. There would be means to withdraw
4 by law, or they can go ahead and carry it to the public,
5 like a referendum is.

6 Now what happens in this whole course is
7 that the whole issue of the initiative will have first
8 the public display of the assembly considering it, and
9 then if the assembly decides not to, the press meanwhile
10 has had a whole big time playing up the issues so the
11 public will know the issues, and then the public will
12 have a chance to vote on it at the next election.

14 the National Municipal League concluded that so-called
15 initiative only as appendix and not as part of its
16 recommended model state constitution?
