

1 MR. SCANLAN: Your point is since they have
2 achieved reapportionment there is really no need for the
3 initiative any more.

4 MR. SAYRE: Now they regard it as less
5 necessary than it was prior to the reapportionment issue,
6 that is true. What I am suggesting is that we raise
7 the requirement of getting an initiative on the ballot
8 but not exclude its ability to get on the ballot.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: As I understand your motion
10 in effect, you are suggesting that there be a right to
11 submit to referendum any bill which names a passage in
12 the Legislature?

13 MR. SAYRE: No.

14 DR. BARD: He goes beyond that.

15 MR. SAYRE: An initiative is a bill of a
16 group of people.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: I know that but you said in
18 your particular situation you would suggest it first
19 be submitted to the Legislature.

20 MR. SAYRE: That is correct.
