

1 MRS. FREEDLANDER: Miscellaneous provisions
2 and we haven't gotten to it.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Mrs. Bothe, does your
4 Committee have the provision on the constitutional
5 amendments?

6 MRS. BOTHE: I have heard we did. It was never
7 officially assigned. We never considered it officially
8 assigned.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Winslow, no committee has
10 as yet considered it.

11 MR. GENTRY: Recall is a provision whereby
12 an elected officer can be discharged or voted out of
13 office, and Senator Gude was the sponsor of the bill in
14 the recent session and also wrote the Commission a
15 letter, and he was invited in and did appear before us,
16 and talked of his reasons for wanting such a provision as
17 this. His bill was to feed it in the Legislature and his
18 proposal was also rejected by the Committee.

19 We recommended there be no provision
20 relating to recall as being unnecessary at this time.
