2 this situation and throw these rascals out of the
3 state and so that the act couldn't be an emergency law.
4 It had to come into effect as of June 1st. Therefore,
5 it was referable and when referable immediately suspended.

6 DR. BURDETTE: I wonder if you aren't
7 speaking to the point of broadening the emergency part
8 of it.

9 MR. CASE: I will bring this up after this is
10 decided.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: Didn't you get away from the
12 difficulty though by giving the power to an existing
13 department?

14 MR. CASE: Vernon, we did it by a little
15 legislative ledger demain, and taking the thing down
16 to the Court of Appeals in a period of great stress.
17 A deaf, dumb, and blind man could have won that case
18 in the Court of Appeals with all the publicity that had
19 been given the situation. You will recall, I think you
20 and I had a very interesting colloquy with respect to
21 this subject as to whether the act we redrew would stand
