

1 Committee or some other group, at least he ought to come
2 from the same political party to support the balance,
3 but I think that you shouldn't go and provide for any
4 special election. I think you would be having special
5 elections all the time.

6 MR. SAYRE: Provided by law.

7 JUDGE ADKINS: That really is my point. If you
8 are going to have that, I wouldn't say special election.
9 You could provide at the next general election, which
10 would be a two-year period, rather than waiting for the
11 full four-year period. I think it would be unfortunate
12 to have a special election; too, because they are pretty ex-
13 pensive.

14 MRS. BOTHE: I think Mr. Case's point is well
15 taken.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: Are you withdrawing the sugges-
17 tion?

18 MRS. BOTHE: No, I don't withdraw it. I modify
19 it, if there were a general election intervening that the
20 vacancy would be so filled.
