4 DR. BARD: No, nothing further here.

5 You will note Roman numeral III --

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Let me make this comment. I had
7 been over that, and correct me if I am wrong, there are
8 some changes that would have to be made to conform to
9 corresponding changes in the bicameral section, but
10 there is nothing that need be discussed in that section
11 at the present time.

12 DR. BARD: That is correct.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Then in the absence of objection,
14 I would say that we would conclude the discussion of the
15 Fourth Report of the Committee on Legislative Department.

16 Let me make this general comment, because the
17 procedure that we are going to follow in this situation
18 has got to be worked out a little more carefully. Obvious-
19 ly, we cannot make progress if we are going to make
20 decisions and then at the next meeting, reexamine and
21 change them, particularly by a narrow margin. I have been
