

1 following the procedure that we are not rigidly bound  
 2 by parliamentary rules at this preliminary stage, and  
 3 therefore have not required that reconsideration be by  
 4 formal motion to reconsider. At some point obviously we  
 5 have to get to that point. Otherwise, we will never  
 6 finish. Whether that point is going to be the next meet-  
 7 ing, I do not know. I propose to have a meeting of the  
 8 Coordinating Committee and discuss this question and re-  
 9 solve it in some way and advise you before the next meet-  
 10 ing.

11 I make the comment now as a preface to a con-  
 12 sideration of the next report, not to shut off debate,  
 13 but to ask you to keep it in mind in connection with the  
 14 consideration of these two matters.

15 We move now to consideration of the Third Re-  
 16 port of the Committee on Miscellaneous Provisions. I  
 17 believe I am correct in saying this has not yet been con-  
 18 sidered by the Commission, is that correct?

19 MRS. BOTHE: I don't think anybody can challenge  
 20 us because they may ask to change their minds. The Third  
 21 Report dates from the last meeting.
