Also within the purview of the education provisions are several, one section of the Declaration of Rights, Article 43, which our Committee understands the Committee on Elective Franchise and Declaration of Rights will not include any of the substance of that provision, or recommend inclusion of any of that provision in the new Constitution, but left to Miscellaneous Provisions, the Committee to consider whether any part of it should be included. It does not deal exclusively with education, hit also besides the confusion, knowledge, virtue, extension of judicial system of education, it goes on to say that land actually devoted to agriculture or farmers' use shall be assessed on the basis of such use, not on the basis of subdivision. We had a speaker from the Farm Bureau who appeared at the hearing, who said that he thought that was as good a place for a provision as any and recommended that it be continued. Our Committee gave no consideration to it at all, and I think it is a miscellaneous provision, and an educational one. Mr. Eney, are we expected to take any action in that with regard to taxing farmland?
