inviolacy of the school funds. The Finance Committee has not yet made any report in that area, and I think we would very much like to go more thoroughly into our views on the subject before you report back to the Commission.

MR. CASE: It seems to us that this is a matter of budgetary and finance primarily relating to the State budget, the State finances, and we are going to come in with a full recommendation on Section 52 of Article 3. This was a term of reference that I understood the Committee had. That is the reason that your Committee wasn't informed.
