

1 inviolacy of the school funds. The Finance Committee has
2 not yet made any report in that area, and I think we would
3 very much like to go more thoroughly into our views on the
4 subject before you report back to the Commission.

5 MR. CASE: It seems to us that this is a mat-
6 ter of budgetary and finance primarily relating to the
7 State budget, the State finances, and we are going to
8 come in with a full recommendation on Section 52 of
9 Article 3. This was a term of reference that I understood
10 the Committee had. That is the reason that your Committee
11 wasn't informed.

12 MRS. BOTHE: I don't want to get into a juris-
13 dictional spat here, Mr. Case.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Let's settle that elsewhere
15 and get on with the recommendations that are before the
16 Committee today.

17 MRS. BOTHE: Of which those are not, except
18 for the recommendation of the Finance Committee.

19 As to those which are, we are not, and we
20 leave to the Committee on Style whether there should be
21 a separate section in the Constitution called Education.
