

1 THE CHAIRMAN: She is saying that the first part
2 of Section 1 would then be pertaining to the free public
3 schools and the second part of Section 1 would be pertain-
4 ing to the schools of higher education and the Section 4
5 clause would only be in the first part of 1 and not the
6 second. That is your point?

7 MRS. BOTHE: Yes.

8 MR. CASE: That there could conceivably be
9 discrimination?

10 THE CHAIRMAN: No, she is speaking only as a
11 matter of draftsmanship.

12 MR. SCANLAN: I think we could accommodate
13 that. I could move the phrase without regard to race,
14 creed, color or national origin, to be the last clause of
15 the revised Section 1.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: That is a matter of phraseology.
17 Can't we get at the question of principle? As I under-
18 stand it, the Committee feels that the system of higher
19 education should be treated in a separate section and not
20 included within the system of free public schools referred
21 to in the first section, and Mrs. Bothe has indicated her
