MR. CASE: What difference does it make whether the admonition to the General Assembly is in the same section or in a different section, so long as the meat of it is there?

MRS, BOTHE: We are not saying it does make a difference. A lot of this is constitutional drafting, whether you make separate sections, whether you make separate paragraphs, and we struggled quite a bit over this. We didn't want to come to the Commission without a concrete proposal. We thought it was the best we could come up with. I suggested perhaps the Committee on Style might be the proper place to determine whether it should be separate sections, just as we are not making a recommendation as to whether it should be a separate article.
