10 MR. GENTRY: Let me just ask a question. If
11 Mr. Case is only concerned about preserving this farmland
12 thing, shouldn't it be referred to his committee? Let's
13 let it rest. No use taking time to discuss it now.

14 While we are still on Sections 1, 2 and 4, treat-
15 ing them all as one thought, is there any further comment
16 about that?

17 MR. CASE: I should like to move that the matter
18 of substance be rereferred to the Miscellaneous Provisions
19 Committee for the purpose of exploring into, through such
20 research as may be necessary, and bringing in a report
