

1 indicated that the emphasis should be on making certain
2 that we are not going to admit all students to my mind is
3 looking at it the backward way. What I would like to
4 make certain in substance that we look at is that we do
5 take care of the requirements of young people, and I can
6 tell you this: That the state of Maryland is not now
7 taking care of the requirements of young people in terms
8 of higher educational needs. If those two things are
9 put together in one, then I would certainly go along with
10 Mr. Case.

13 research on this question that would resolve the question.
14 What you would be trying to do would be to get interpre-
15 tation of language, which this Committee has come up with,
