trying to make. I am with you 100 per cent in what you are saying with reference to the system, how it should be operated. My only point is whether or not this language changes it.

DR. BARD: I think the word maintain, may be changing it some, and here I am with you.

MR. CASE: That is what I want to find out.

May I state what I believe to THE CHAIRMAN: be the principles that most at least of the Commission subscribe to. If they don't, we can take a vote and decide the principles: One, that the system of free public schools, certainly through high school, are to be as I indicated in the first clause of Section 1; the obligation of the General Assembly, that they are to be free, they are to be sufficient and they are to be open to everyone without discrimination. Secondly, that the General Assembly shall provide assistance to encourage support of other public educational institutions in this same area This, I take it, refers more particularly to adult education programs, as a part of the public school system. Thirdly, that the General Assembly shall provide either
