2 couragement or support; whatnot, for higher education in
3 the State of Maryland, without imposing on the Legislature
4 the requirement that it provide a complete system of
5 higher education, sufficient for the higher education of
6 everyone in Maryland; fourthly, that it is not intended
7 that the higher education colleges be free; fifthly, that
8 it is not intended that the control of those institutions
9 of admission practices be removed, so that they are open
10 to everyone.

11 Have I stated what is the consensus of opinion
12 of the Commission, or is there any disagreement with any
13 of those five propositions?

14 MRS. BOTHE: Just one, Mr. Eney, and that is,
15 I think that the Committee felt that the provision, re,
16 higher education, should provide for a system and that
17 the system would not be all-pervasive and comprehensive,
18 but we wanted to continue the concept that there be some
19 kind of a system, just like there is an elementary school
20 system.
