THE CHAIRMAN: Is there any disagreement with that proposition? (  $\ensuremath{^{\mid}}$ 

DR. BARD: Partial disagreement. I think it would be worded better if it stated, The General Assembly shall provide for a system of public higher education, which takes into account the contributions of non-public institutions.

THE CHAIRMAN: You are talking language now.

DR. BARD: It is more than language. It is concept. That is all relationships that we have had with non-public schools make it clear that they exist within another orbit; that they are not going to be supported in the same way as public higher educational institutions and yet any system would take into account their assistance and their contributions.

THE CHAIRMAN: That is what I understood was the position of the Committee as just stated by Mrs. Bothe, that there would be no express reference in the Constitution to aid to private colleges, but the language would be so drawn that the Legislature could aid private colleges.

DR. BARD: But not mandatory. I think unless
