have control over the initial appropriations. There would

still remain a balance between the University and the

Legislature, which we think is desirable, but we also feel

that the Board of Regents should have complete control of the funds once they have been appropriated.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any questions? Dr. Templeton?

DR. TEMPLETON: I have a question about the

future in terms of language used by Mrs. Bothe. Section 2 calls for a system of public higher education. Section 3 calls for the designation of the University of Maryland as a State university and Mrs. Bothe has used the word, merge. What is the meaning of this?

MRS. BOTHE: Please don't take my comment for accuracy in the Report. We discussed at some length the desirability of having a more uniform, statewide system of higher education. We recognize that is someplace off in the future and may never occur. However, we felt, just as the secondary school systems of the State are unified, that perhaps an ultimate objective in this constitutional
