

1 terday and today, while very considerable, indicates that  
2 the kind of consideration which we have been giving and  
3 want to give to these Reports takes time.

4 All of us have been earmarking the regular  
5 meeting date of the Commission for better than a year now,  
6 and I think it would probably be unwise to even consider a  
7 series of dates that differed at all from that date; at  
8 least, that it should include that date. Our next meet-  
9 ing is the third Monday in August, and I think that is the  
10 15th.

11 Now, it seems to me that our experience yes-  
12 terday and today has demonstrated that a consecutive two-day  
13 meeting is not only desirable but absolutely essential, and  
14 that an interlude, breaking it off with an interlude of  
15 a day is undesirable. For that reason, it would seem to  
16 me that we should consider the next time, either again  
17 Sunday and Monday, or Monday and Tuesday. It has also  
18 been suggested that August, being the middle of the sum-  
19 mer, and indeed the 15th getting on to the end of the  
20 summer, that it might be that we will have a better atten-  
21 dance to not interfere with the weekend and consider
