

1 THE CHAIRMAN: How many would prefer the Monday,  
2 Tuesday combination?

3 MR. BROOKS: Three.

4 MR. MILES: Let me say my vote on Monday and  
5 Tuesday is, assume you are going to recess at 5 o'clock?

6 THE CHAIRMAN: The second day. The first day  
7 we would probably have a night session. I would assume  
8 from this that we could get a more representative atten-  
9 dance, and this surprises me, on Sunday and Monday, the  
10 21st and 22nd.

11 MRS. BOTHE: I would suggest also, Mr. Eney,  
12 that because of the length of these two-day meetings  
13 that a number of committees will want more time in order  
14 to be ready for the next meeting.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: One thing we must do if it is at  
16 all possible is to get the reports in in time to have them  
17 typed. This is really a tremendous task. It is not mere-  
18 ly a question of reproducing thirty copies of these reports  
19 for this group. Literally hundreds of reports are re-  
20 produced for circulation, and this ties up the State Office  
21 to such an extent that we just can't get them out.
