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still appropriate to have a limit. I didn't know that we had voted definitely on that point, had we?

THE CHAIRMAN: I am sorry, Mr. Sayre, I didn't catch that.

MR. SAYRE: Have we voted that we will leave it open to the Legislature to determine its own number?

DR. BARD: Yes.

THE CHAIRMAN: I think we had, subject to the qualifications imposed by the subsequent sections, as to the redetermination of this question by the Legislature at periodic intervals.

MR. SAYRE: I can envisage increasing problems, where the easiest expedient is to just keep adding numbers. I think it would be appropriate to have a limit. Is it appropriate? Is that a reconsideration?

THE CHAIRMAN: That was discussed at some length at the last meeting. That was the recommendation of the Committee and the vote was against it. I don't recall the division. We have submitted other votes. If you want to submit it again, I will do so.

MR. SAYRE: I would like to submit that a limit
