several of the smaller counties of the State would then have no representation, and consequently, no independent voice in the Legislature. I do not think that is a matter which should be decided in this rather back door manner. It may well be that the facts will indicate that that has to be done, but it is going to be a very serious problem for those portions of the State which fall in that category, and I don't think that it should be foreclosed unless we are prepared to have extensive debate on that precise issue at this time, so I would strenuously urge, as I did at the June 20 meeting, that this limitation be eliminated from the draft of the Constitution.

We have argued pro and con here about confidence in the Legislature. We have tried to draft a document which indicates confidence in the Legislature. It seems to me that this question should be left for future development in the political field and not the Constitution.
