Section 3.

DR. BARD: The State shall be divided into legislative districts for the election of members of the Senate as provided by law, and shall also be divided into legislative districts for the election of members of the House of Delegates as provided by law. Each legislative district shall consist of compact and contiguous territory without limitation or extension because of existing county or city lines.

I might pause here to say that we kept the two concepts of compact and contiguous.

The ratio of the number of senators in each senatorial district to the population of such district shall be such that the largest ratio shall not exceed the smallest by more than ten per cent. The ratio of the number of delegates in each house district, note we use
