7 DR. BARD: The State shall be divided into
8 legislative districts for the election of members of the
9 Senate as provided by law, and shall also be divided into
10 legislative districts for the election of members of the
11 House of Delegates as provided by law. Each legislative
12 district shall consist of compact and contiguous terri-
13 tory without limitation or extension because of existing
14 county or city lines.

15 I might pause here to say that we kept the two
16 concepts of compact and contiguous.

17 The ratio of the number of senators in each
18 senatorial district to the population of such district
19 shall be such that the largest ratio shall not exceed the
20 smallest by more than ten per cent. The ratio of the
21 number of delegates in each house district, note we use
