house district, to the population of such district shall be such that the largest ratio shall not exceed the smallest by more than ten per cent.

I would like to call your attention to one point, and that is that at the last meeting this group, we want to be fair about this, this group voted that we not set this into the documents; that the latter portion of this reading which just took place not be included. However, we are asking the Commission to reconsider on this point in lieu of the way we have stated it.

used in the last two sentences of the above Section 3 is necessary because Section 4 permits the General Assembly itself to determine whether there will be single-member districts or multiple-member districts. If the General Assembly decides upon multiple-member districts, then the ten per cent limitation must be expressed in terms of a ratio rather than terms of a comparison of the largest district with the smallest district. However, as stated a moment ago, it may well be that this Committee still feels, and we hope that it doesn't, that this matter of
