7 adoption of the Constitution?

8 DR. BARD: That is correct.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Do you think there could be  
10 any possibility that would be misunderstood?

11 DR. BARD: It might, Mr. Chairman. What recom-  
12 mendation do you make?

13 DR. BURDETTE: I have a question on that very  
14 same line, if I may ask it. I don't know what the word  
15 extension is intended to mean. I see limitation, limita-  
16 tion or extension.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: I would assume it would mean an  
18 extension of the boundary lines.

19 DR. BARD: Yes.
