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DR. BARD: Yes. It would then read, Each legislative district shall consist of compact and contiguous territory.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any objection to the change?
All right, so made.

Before we discuss it, may I ask

JUDGE ADKINS: Mr. Chairman, to move on to another point, I would like to get on this question of the ten per cent limitation.

a question that I wanted to ask before, Dr. Bard? Ratios are sometimes very confusing to me. Is a variation of ten per cent in the ratio exactly the same as a variation

THE CHAIRMAN:

of ten per cent in population, if you are thinking in terms of a one-member district?

DR. BARD: I think what we are thinking of here is variation of ten per cent in the spread. Wouldn't that be true, Dr. Winslow? This is what we have in mind?

THE CHAIRMAN: Would a variation of ten per cent in the spread of the ratio be exactly the same as a variation of ten per cent in the spread of the population in a one-man district?
