We recognize that the position taken at the last Commission meeting was in opposition to our Committee's view, and I do think that we ought to clear this up first. Otherwise, the discussion we have just had would be purely academic.

THE CHAIRMAN: Judge Adkins?

JUDGE ADKINS: I urged at the June 20 meeting that the ten per cent limitation be eliminated, and I am of the same opinion, for the reasons which I just stated in connection with the limitation on the size, number of delegates. It seems to me that this issue is not quite as definitively but certainly almost so, forecloses the question of whether or not after the 1970 census all counties shall be entitled to at least some representation. It did not seem to me that certainty at this point is essential. Now we have avoided throughout this Constitution what to me has been a new word, and I can't pronounce it but it has been used frequently, specificity, or some such word. We have used that argument. We have adopted that argument as a basic concept,
