DR. BARD: I would like to call the Commission's attention to the fact that the vote/was taken last time was reached by a single vote, really. The decision was reached by a single vote and then only after some of the members had left. This is one reason why we wanted to open up this thing again. Another point that was raised on this matter, and I hope that other members of the Committee will talk to this point because on this issue, our Committee was unanimous. There were other issues in which we were divided, but on this particular

issue there was unanimity.

MR. SCANLAN: I, for one, felt that to leave this open would just continue the generation of litigation which has been going on about this issue, and moreover, would insure that that litigation would now be transferred to the Federal courts. I was hoping that whatever the standard, whether it be five per cent, ten per cent or just leave it blank at this time in terms of percentage points, we at least would be given a standard certificate for the Legislature in future and for our own State courts, because as you see a little later on, we come to the
