7 broad belief that I hold, and that is that while I be-
8 lieve that a constitution is written to last for a long
9 period of time, and I think Judge Adkins has stated this
10 well, nevertheless I also believe that a constitution
11 should reflect the times in which it is being written,
12 and this one idea is certainly a key idea of our times,
13 the concept of a Federal union as such, that a state does
14 not in any sense abdicate its authority, and we do have
15 the authority as a state to indicate where we stand on
16 this question, and this was the position I think largely
17 of our Committee.
