WINSLOW: Yes, sir, not naming them off, but just from personal knowledge, I know that North Carolina, as of a month ago, elected new representatives and for the first time in the history of the State, some of the counties will not have any representatives in the State Legislature when it convenes next January.

MR. SCANLAN: Kansas and New Jersey not long ago, the same thing.

DR. WINSLOW: In Nebraska, the unicameral legislature is actually an illustration, but that is another case, because it is unicameral, but there are 90 counties in the State of Nebraska and 50, I think, represented so that you don't have one county, one representative.

THE CHAIRMAN: Then let's consider the question as divided, and the question now arises solely on whether the Constitution shall contain a limitation,
