2 DR. BARD: That is better.

3 DR. BURDETTE: That still has a grammatical
4 error, by saying by one but not more than two senators.
5 The one and the plural of delegates and senators won't
6 go together.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Let's refer that to the Committee
8 on Style.

9 DR. BURDETTE: This is a good illustration of
10 how the committees can perhaps working through the
11 Executive Director, get out some of these things that
12 English purists would squabble over. They don't change
13 substance.

14 MR. BROOKS: We have the idea that we do want
15 to refer this to Style.

16 MR. MILES: For my edification, would you
17 repeat what you said a while ago?

18 MR. BROOKS: All right. First, this is sub-
19 stitute for Section 4: Each senatorial district shall
20 be represented by at least one, but nor more than two
21 senators.
