Within one calendar year after official some discussion: publication of the population figures of each decennial census of the United States, the General Assembly shall redistrict the State in accordance with the provisions of this Article. If the General Assembly has not enacted a plan of redistricting within such one year period, the governor shall promulgate a plan of redistricting which shall become law upon publication by the governor. the governor has not published a plan of redistricting within sixty days after the expiration of such one year period, the Court of Appeals in the exercise of original jurisdiction may upon the petition of any qualified voter order the governor to promulgate and publish a plan of redistricting.

Because members of this Commission have not had this paper until today, I would like to read the comment:

In keeping with the Committee's view that the General Assembly should be strengthened and given more responsibility rather than less, this section leaves reapportionment to the General Assembly itself in the first instance.

We would like to emphasize that.
