

1 MR. SCANLAN: What are you talking about?

2 DR. BURDETTE: Am I not right? I am thinking about
3 the next dicennial census in which the election will be
4 in 1982 instead of 1984. He is talking about 1974, and
5 I am thinking of what you get into in the future, because
6 every twenty years you have to do it within two years of
7 the census. It has been coming out now in the summer.
8 It depends on the State. We don't know where we would
9 be -- the summer of the year following. That is, in
10 other words, it would be 1971, 1981, but that is close
11 going in 1981 to get an election of '82.

12 DR. BARD: The way they are talking now, they
13 are talking about getting it out by the winter of the
14 same year.

15 DR. BURDETTE: Even so, a two-year proposition.
16 It may be all right.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Wouldn't you miss it anyhow on
18 a one-year limitation on the basis of the census of 1980
19 if the figures were available in 1981, in the summer of
20 1981?

21 MR. SCANLAN: They are available quicker than
