report it would probably be desirable that the Commission not take any final vote today on the question of unicameralism versus bicameralism. A number suggested that this is a question they would like to reserve decision on until they see more of the shape of the document with respect to the Executive Department and other departments. That decision was transmitted to Dr. Bard and he is aware of it. Dr. Bard, you may proceed.

DR. BARD: I might say, Mr. Chairman, our

Committee concurs in respect to this second thought
with regard to the discussion of the subject of unicameralism
versus bicameralism.

The Committee at this particular time would like in an exploratory sampling on the part of the entire Commission in respect to how Commission members feel in regard to this question without taking a vote at this particular session. As was made clear, it is our feeling that the reports of other Committees would have such important bearing on the final decision in this respect that we would like to hold it until that
