we say something, namely, we may express the inherent 1 equitable power they have now. 2 MR. MARTINEAU: It wouldn't depend upon sime-3 one filing a Bill of Complaint in Equity. It would be 4 that they have power to adopt a plan, period. 5 MR. CASE: In original jurisdiction. 6 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Bard, which is the proposi-7 tion the Committee wants to espouse? 8 DR. BARD: I think the one just stated would 9 probably be the one, by Mr. Scanlan. 10 Do you want to take a sense 11 THE CHAIRMAN: of the Committee on that? 12 DR. BARD: Before we take the sense of the 13 Committee on this question, shouldn't we take the sense 14 of the Commission on the first two recommendations together 15 or do you think we ought to do it all as one? 16 THE CHAIRMAN: I have a hunch that if we clear 17 this, the others will fall in. 18 DR. BARD: All right. Let's take the sense of 19 20 the last point. MR. CLAGETT: Do I understand the question, 21
