3 MR. MARTINEAU: It wouldn't depend upon some-
4 one filing a Bill of Complaint in Equity. It would be
5 that they have power to adopt a plan, period.

6 MR. CASE: In original jurisdiction.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Bard, which is the proposi-
8 tion the Committee wants to espouse?

9 DR. BARD: I think the one just stated would
10 probably be the one, by Mr. Scanlan.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: Do you want to take a sense
12 of the Committee on that?

13 DR. BARD: Before we take the sense of the
14 Committee on this question, shouldn't we take the sense
15 of the Commission on the first two recommendations together,
16 or do you think we ought to do it all as one?

17 THE CHAIRMAN: I have a hunch that if we clear
18 this, the others will fall in.

19 DR. BARD: All right. Let's take the sense of
20 the last point.
