DR. BARD: We have the full report. Mr. Brooks, did every member of the Commission get a copy of the first full report of the hearing?

MR. BROOKS: No, they did not, only you. Committee members.

DR. BARD: I am sorry, I had felt that every member of the Commission had received a copy the full report.

We had two hearings with members of the Legislature Committee. I would want to say that Senator James, who is President of the Senate, and Speaker of the House Mr. Mandel, as well as other members of the Committee, were most cooperative it to assistance that they gave us in respect to for questions dealing with issues that we raised in to our Committee's deliberations. Perhaps fore among those fourteen questions was the one dealir unicameralism and bicameralism.
