

1 DR. BARD: We have the full report. Mr.
2 Brooks, did every member of the Commission get a
3 copy of the first full report of the hearing?

4 MR. BROOKS: No, they did not, only your
5 Committee members.

6 DR. BARD: I am sorry, I had felt that
7 every member of the Commission had received a copy
8 the full report.

9 We had two hearings with members of the
10 Legislature Committee. I would want to say that
11 Senator James, who is President of the Senate, and
12 Speaker of the House Mr. Mandel, as well as other
13 members of the Committee, were most cooperative in
14 the assistance that they gave us in respect to four
15 questions dealing with issues that we raised in
16 to our Committee's deliberations. Perhaps foremost
17 among those fourteen questions was the one dealing
18 unicameralism and bicameralism.

19 Members of the Legislature Committee
20 divided in this regard. Interestingly enough, Senator
21 James and Senator Hughes, this was at an open session.
