The governor's apportionment and redistricting plan shall be published in the manner provided for acts of the General Assembly and shall have the force of law upon such publication. Upon the application of any qualified voter. the Supreme Court of the State of Maryland in the exercise of original exclusive and final jurisdiction shall review the governor's apportionment and redistricting plan and shall have jurisdiction to make orders to amend the plan and shall have jurisdiction to make orders to amend the plan to comply with the requirement of this Constitution or if the governor has failed to promulgate an apportionment and redistricting plan within the time provided to make one or more orders establishing such a plan.
