2 The governor's apportionment and redistricting plan shall
3 be published in the manner provided for acts of the
4 General Assembly and shall have the force of law upon such
5 publication. Upon the application of any qualified voter,
6 the Supreme Court of the State of Maryland in the exercise
7 of original exclusive and final jurisdiction shall review
8 the governor's apportionment and redistricting plan and
9 shall have jurisdiction to make orders to amend the plan
10 and shall have jurisdiction to make orders to amend the
11 plan to comply with the requirement of this Constitution
12 or if the governor has failed to promulgate an apportion-
13 ment and redistricting plan within the time provided to
14 make one or more orders establishing such a plan.

15 That is it.

17 approve the principle of that rather than the precise
18 language?
