5 MR. DELLA: Mr. Chairman, I think the thought  
6 is pretty good, but I think it would be just a waste of  
7 time. I think when we get into this type of situation,  
8 the Legislature is going to be the ones to really act on  
9 it, and if they get the report of this subcommittee, they  
10 will tear it apart and start afresh. I think it is a  
11 waste of time in even setting up a governor's committee.

12 MR. BOND: Again, as the Chairman stated about  
13 ten minutes ago, this flies in the face of the adoption  
14 of the separation of powers. I am opposed to it. The  
15 Legislature should at least have one crack.

16 MR. HOFF: I am in favor of it because of that.  
17 I think if you throw this matter of reapportionment into  
18 the hands of the Legislature, you will have gerrymandering  
19 from the word go. As a practical matter, I think the  
20 governor or a commission or the courts would do a far
