

1 related principles to further discussion? Can we set a
2 limit on those three levels of responsibility?

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Except that this motion,
4 Dr. Templeton, cuts right across that. The proposition
5 of this motion is that you take it out completely, com-
6 pletely out of the sphere of the Legislature initially,
7 and at all times and at no point does it go to the Legis-
8 lature.

9 DR. TEMPLETON: I have been very crude and un-
10 kind to Mr. Sayre because I disregarded his motion. I
11 am thinking now about the levels of responsibility in
12 order to achieve the formulations of a valid plan.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: I understand you. What you are
14 saying is, you oppose Mr. Sayre's motion and you think it
15 ought to be left in the three levels of the government's
16 successor.

17 DR. TEMPLETON: Yes.

18 MR. CLAGETT: Mr. Chairman, I think this prin-
19 ciple that is really what probably this whole Commission
20 agrees with, but what Mr. Sayre has done here to to raise
21 the question of practicality, and his motion goes squarely
