THE CHAIRMAN: I think that is correct, to be 1 proposed by a commission and promulgated by the governor, 2 in accordance with the recommendation of that commission 3 or with his comments of disagreement. 4 MR. CLAGETT: Can I be assured that we will 5 have a chance to vote on the revitalized approach as 6 suggested by Mr. Case? 7 THE CHAIRMAN: If this motion is defeated, you 8 Mr. Case? 9 will. MR. CASE: I have got another idea. I don't 10 know whether it is appropriate, as an alternative to this 11 12 suggestion. Let's take this and then we THE CHAIRMAN: 13 will take up any others. Are you ready for the question? 14 MR. CASE: You don't know what my idea is, though. 15 DR. BARD: We have to settle this first. 16 THE CHAIRMAN: You say it is an alternate. 17 Question. DR. TEMPLETON: 18 THE CHAIRMAN: Are you ready for the question? 19 All right. All those in favor of the motion, please 20 signify by a show of hands. Opposed. The motion is lost, 21.
