

1 me we want to make this in an expeditious manner, that as
2 soon as the figures of the census are projected, that the
3 governor could call a special session of the General
4 Assembly to work just on this one particular issue, and
5 under the present laws, of course, the special session
6 could last 30 days. In other words, it appears to me that
7 the same thing is going to be projected into this new
8 constitution; that they could work out a reapportionment
9 program within that 30-day period. That would be the
10 only issue they would have to contend with in that par-
11 ticular session. I think you could get something done in
12 that particular time that would be satisfactory to most
13 of the people.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: All right. Let me try to state
15 Mr. Case's proposition, and then we can vote on it as a
16 matter of principle. As I understand it, it will provide
17 that within a stipulated time, and we are not at the
18 moment fixing the time after the census figures become
19 available, the governor shall call the Legislature into
20 session and present to it a plan of redistricting. The
21 Legislature is to have the power to prepare its own plan,
