4 subsequently held invalid, then the plan proposed by
5 the governor shall become effective. Is that the sub-
6 stance of it, Dick?

7 MR. CASE: Yes.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: Is there any discussion of that?
9 Mr. Melvin?

10 MR. CLAGETT: Suppose the governor's plan is
11 invalid.

12 MR. MELVIN: That is my question.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: I assume you are back in the
14 courts.

15 MR. CASE: Yes. The court takes up from that
