some illustrations along these lines. They believed that traditionally bicameralism has operated well.

I think this would summarize the feelings on the part of those members who attended our hearings in connection with this particular question.

Interestingly enough, the strongest support for unicameralism came from those who are members of the State Senate and the strongest support for bicameralism came from those who are members of the House of Delegates. There are other members of the Committee who may want to add to this very brief summary on this question.
