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you would just have to wait until the one after that, if there would be time.

> What is your overall limitation? THE CHAIRMAN:

The next succeeding election, if MRS. BOTHE: as much as six months away from the announcement.

THE CHAIRMAN: If it is two years away, what is the overall presentation?

> Initial presentation. MRS. BOTHE:

On the enactment? THE CHAIRMAN:

MRS. BOTHE: Eighteen months.

MR. CASE: Mr. Chairman, when I was describing the thing I gave to Harry, I tried to work out some times. It seems to me that the really only sensible way to do it is to sit down with the calendar and work out your different combinations. I don't see how you can do that. You have sort of a different concept. I would move that the determination of the times at which these things fall into place be recommitted to the Committee for further study and analysis and be ordered to report back at the next meeting.
