4 comment following Section 5 that a redistricting bill be
5 not subject to referendum be considered further by that
6 committee but also be considered by your Committee, Mr.
7 Gentry.

8 MR. GENTRY: Yes, sir.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Will you take that under con-
10 sideration and discuss it with this Committee?

11 MR. GENTRY: Yes.

12 MR. SCANLAN: You don't want an expression

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Do you want it, Dr. Bard?

16 DR. BARD: I think it would be helpful, yes.
17 Mr. Scanlan could speak to us for that.

20 is able to satisfy the Commission on that point. It still
21 would present a situation where validly enacted reapportion-
ment bill could be passed by the Legislature, approved
