BROOKS: This latter question is one that is being considered and debated certainly by the staff, if not altogether by the Committee, from the standpoint that under the provisions of a constitution such as this there is no reason why the governor cannot call a special session of the Legislature after the general election at which the delegates have been served or have been elected so that it is a real question as to which Legislature shall be called in December after the election of a special session is needed.
